EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19

DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF ALL CLASSES AT ALL LEVELS IN PUBLIC LEARNING INSTITUTIONS INCLUDING BAYAMBANG POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE AND SUSPENSION OF WORK IN LGU BAYAMBANG ON MARCH 27, 2023

WHEREAS, on March 27 – April 2, 2023, the Municipality of Bayambang will be celebrating its 409th Founding Anniversary to be participated by the seventy-seven (77) Barangay, public institutions, and Non-Government Organizations (NGO's);

WHEREAS, in line with this year's festivities theme: "*Bayambang Isulong ang Ninanais na Kaunlaran*," the municipal government of Bayambang prepared various events to entertain local and foreign tourist and at the same time highlights Bayambanguenos' significant contribution to the town's prosperity;

WHEREAS, one of the highlights of the festivities in the Revelry Triduum Mass, Grand Motorcade, and Street Dancing Competition on March 27, starting at Five o'clock in the morning till 11 o'clock in the evening;

WHEREAS, the expected heavy influx of residents and visitors in the Municipality will surely cause traffic congestion, difficulty in securing transportation, and lead to inconvenience in going to schools;

WHEREAS, the suspension of all classes at all levels in both **public and private** learning institutions in our municipality is to ensure public safety and order and effectively manage vehicular and human traffic well as reduce congestion, inconvenience, and/or emergencies;

WHEREAS, the decision to suspend classes in private schools and work in private establishments and national government agencies in the municipality will be left to the discretion of the head of office or management; and

WHEREAS, frontline services at Municipal Hall such as Municipal Treasurers Office, Local Civil Registrar's Office, Office of the Building Official, Municipal Health Office, and among others, will have a skeletal force to man the office to receive payments or applications and work suspension does not apply to offices involved in emergency response, maintenance of peace and order, traffic management, solid waste management and health care services, and clean and green service.
