**AN ORDER PLACING THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN THRU THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION MANAGEMENT COUNCIL TO “BLUE” ALERT STATUS FROM MARCH 25, 2023, 0700H UNTIL MARCH 26, 2023, 0659H AND ALERT STATUS “RED” EFFECTIVE MARCH 26, 2023, 0700H UNTIL APRIL 02, 2023, FOR THE CELEBRATION OF BAYAMBANG TOWN FIESTA 2023, AND EXTENDED UNTIL APRIL 10, 2023, FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF THE HOLY WEEK**

**WHEREAS**, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution and Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provide that Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote health and safety of the people;

**WHEREAS**, General Welfare Clause Under Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that “every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, to strengthen monitoring and prompt coordination of agencies concerned and the LGU for to the celebration of the 409th Bayambang Town Fiesta this March 27, 2023-April 02, 2023, it is expected that there will be an influx of locals and visitors to join in the celebration, and with this, there is the need to raise the alert status to “BLUE” from March 25, 2023 to March 26, 2023, and to alert status “RED” on March 26, 2023 at 7:00 AM to April 02, 2023, to ensure the welfare of all revelers, spectators, and participants and the success of the activities of the town fiesta celebration;

**WHEREAS**, there is also the need to extend the “RED” alert status until April 10, 2023, for the observance of the Holy Week which will also attract visitors, and, serve as homecoming for our “kabaleyan” which will result to various social, religious gatherings, and activities in the town;

**WHEREAS**, due to the presence and possible threat of COVID-19 in the country, Alert Level System and Guidelines applicable to the town’s COVID-19 alert status shall be observed and implemented by all agencies concerned;
