EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27

DECLARING THE SUSPENSION OF ALL CLASSES AT ALL LEVELS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE LEARNING INSTITUTIONS INCLUDING BAYAMBANG POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE AND SUSPENSION OF WORK AT LGU BAYAMBANG ON APRIL 05, 2023

WHEREAS, through a Resolution, the Sanguniang Bayan of Bayambang recommended April 05, 1614 to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) as the Foundation Day of the town. The Office of the President through Proclamation No. 131 dated March 24, 2011, has officially declared that such date is the Foundation Day of the Municipality of Bayambang;

WHEREAS, in line with Presidential Proclamation No. 131 for this year's commemoration of the town's **409th Foundation Day**, it is essential and fitting that all classes at all levels in **public and private** learning institutions including Bayambang Polytechnic College, and work at the Local Government Unit in our municipality be suspended to allow our constituents to commemorate and observe the importance of our town's Founding Anniversary;

WHEREAS, the decision to suspend work in private establishments and national government agencies in the municipality will be left to the discretion of the head of office or management;

WHEREAS, General Welfare Clause Under Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, x x x promote health and safety x x x, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.";

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Code also emphasizes the responsibility of local government units of to ensure and support the preservation and enrichment of culture (Title 3, Chapter 3, Section 458, Paragraph a-5, sub-paragraph XVI of R.A. 7160);

WHEREAS, the provisions of the code are anchored on the Constitutionally-declared policy that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress and promote total human liberation and development (Article 3, Section 17 of the 1987 Constitution);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, and pursuant to the General Welfare Clause Under Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 do *hereby declare the suspension of classes at all levels in public and private learning institutions including Bayambang Polytechnic College and suspension of work at LGU Bayambang on April 05, 2023.*
