EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 29 Series of 2023

ESTABLISHING A PREPAREDNESS MEASURES IN THE OBSERVANCE OF LENTEN SEASON IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, Section 15. Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution and Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provide that Local Government Units within their territorial jurisdiction shall promote health and safety of the people;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Proclamation No. 90, s. 2022. Malacañang declares April 6. 7 and 10 as regular holidays. and April 8 a special non-working holiday in observance of this year's Holy Week (April 6-9) and Day of Valor (April 10). we will be expecting an influx of visitors and kababayans to visit and return home respectively, especially during the holy week;

WHEREAS, based on the memorandum dated March 27, 2023 issued by the Pangasinan PDRRMO, requesting all Local DRRM Office with our DRRM Council to formulate preparedness measures "OPLAN SEMANA 2023." Placing emphasis on Information and Education Campaign and keeping our resorts and rim er areas strictly monitored to mitigate any untoward incidents that may occur. and to keep our fellow citizens safe and secure during the observance of the Lenten Season:

WHEREAS. a surge of gathering for religious and leisure purposes is anticipated in view of the Holy Week.

WHEREAS, the continued implementation of proactive measures is necessary to ensure the utmost protection of the health of the Bayambanguenos:

NOW THEREFORE, I **MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE- QUIAMBAO**, Municipal Mayor / MDRRMC Chairman of Bayambang, Pangasinan by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I hereby order the following:

SECTION I. CURFEW. There shall be a local curfew from 1 2:00 o'clock in the midnight to 4:00 o'clock in the morning among minors on April 6-8, 2023.

SECTION II. MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS.

A. Existing guidelines on Covid-19 protocols shall be followed / observed.

SECTION III. G U IDELINES FOR RELIGIOUS PRACTICES FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF LENTEN SEASON

"Baley ko, Pawilen ko, Aroen ko, tan Tulungan ko"





A. Religious gatherings are allowed provided that the minimum public health protocols are properly observed.

NOTE. The organizers shall be responsible on strict monitoring.

- B. Accordingly, the following religious activities shall be allowed during the Lenten Season provided that the minimum health protocol is observed:
 - i. Conduct of Holy mass in churches or in private venues;
 - ii. Reading of "Pasyon"
 - iii. Prayer of the Holy Rosary and prayer vigils;
 - iv. Other similar practices.
- C. Religious gatherings and other related activities in public plaza and amphitheaters are strictly prohibited on GOOD Friday.
- D. Kissing or touching of the cross during adoration and veneration of the Holy Cross and other religious image are strongly prohibited.
- E. Churches and host Barangays should strictly implement minimum health protocol inside and within the church premises.
- F. Religious activity organizers are advised to create their respective Emergency Response Team or marshals to ensure the safety of all devotees or attendees.

SECTION IV GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR LIQUOR BAN AND OTHER PROTOCOLS

- A. Selling and consumption of liquor in the entire municipality shall be allowed but have to be responsible drinkers.
- B. Strict implementation of health protocols for markets and continuous foot patrol from covering barangays to monitor compliance.
- C. Resort owners shall ensure the safety of its guests.

SECTION V. ACTIVATING AND MOBILIZING THE MDRRMC and BDRRMC.

- A. Members of the DRRMC (Municipal and Barangay) are directed to monitor in compliance with the guidelines stated this Order.
- B. Activate the Emergency Operation Center (Municipal and Barangay) for close
- C. monitoring and submit Situational Report in connection with the aforementioned event covering April 01 to 10, 2023 as needed.
- D. Members of BDRRMC are directed to monitor all tourist attractions such as but not limited to pilgrimage sites, resorts, parks and other sites of convergence.
- E. Monitor closely the weather system, tropical cyclone bulletins, warnings and other advisories issued by the DOST-PAGASA, DENR-MGB, and other surveillance agencies.

SECTION VI DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICE/DEPARTMENTS:

1. Mayor's Office

a. Provide logistical support and supervision throughout the operational period

b. Issue directives and protocols to ensure safety and security of constituents and tourists throughout the operational period.

2. PNP

- a. Overall in-charge in the security and orderliness of the Oplan Sum Vac 2023 throughout the operational period.
- b. Ensure the free flow of traffic.
- c. Maintain peace and order situation throughout the operational period.
- d. Conduct regular patrolling throughout the operational period.
- e. Assist in the enforcement of Municipal Ordinances.
- f. Issue citation tickets to traffic law violators
- g. Establish tourist assistance desk/Police Assistance Desk to strategic places in the Municipality of Bayambang.
- h. Provide and indirect supervisions and instructions to the barangay officials in maintaining the peace and order situations in their respective AOR throughout the Lenten season.
- i. Emphasize Information Education Campaign (IEC) on the protocols and guidelines enumerated herein.
- j. Shall team-up with RHU, MDRRMO and BFP for the establishment of First-Aid stations in strategic areas.
- k. Perform other assigned task.

3. BFP

- a. Ensure the fire safety of resorts in AOR.
- b. Provide manpower assistance in provision of information assistance to tourist.
- c. Shall team-up with RHU, MDRRMO and PNP for the establishment of First-Aid stations in strategic areas Perform other assigned task.

4. MDRRMO

- a. Conduct Regular Foot Patrolling.
- b. Enforce Municipal Ordinances.
- c. Ensures the observance of Minimum public Health Protocols.
- d. Established first aid stations of and provide a stand-by ambulance assistance especially during operational period.
- e. Shall team-up with RHU, MDRRMO PNP and BFP for the establishment of First-Aid stations in strategic areas
- f. Perform other assigned task.

5. MENRO

- a. Regular collection of garbage in designated collection areas.
- b. Advise resort owners to segregate their garbage.
- c. Spearhead, together with municipal treasury, the enforcement of penalty to all violators of municipal ordinance on proper waste disposal.
- d. Perform other assigned task.

6. RHU

- a. Spearhead the implementation of minimum public health protocols.
- b. Monitor the compliance of the resort owners and their guest to existing minimum public health protocols
- c. Assist in the provisions of first aid stations and provide a stand-by ambulance assistance.
- d. Shall team-up with PNP, MDRRMO and BFP for the establishment of First-Aid stations in strategic areas
- e. Perform others assigned task.

7. Municipal Security Group/Guards/General Services

- a. Responsible in the orderliness and cleanliness around municipal grounds to public market.
- b. Assist in the enforcing the municipal ordinances and guidelines together with other enforcers throughout the operational period.
- c. Assist the MENRO during garbage collection.
- d. Perform other assigned task.

8. Municipal Traffic Enforcers

- a. Responsible in managing the traffic throughout the operational period.
- b. Ensure the proper implementation of parking rules and protocols.
- c. Assist Bayambang Police Station in enforcing the traffic rules and regulations and the parking rules and protocols.
- d. Perform other assigned task.

9. Tourism Office

- a. Shall designate an officer for tourist assistance.
- b. Perform other assigned task.

10. Barangay Officials, BHERTs/BPATs

- a. Ensure the safety of every constituents and tourist in their respective AOR.
- b. Conduct regular monitoring in bodies of water or resorts and other tourist destinations in their respective AOR.
- c. Conduct close coordination with PNP, BFP, RHU, and other concerned offices in times of emergency cases.
- d. Shall be available 24/7 at their respective barangay hall throughout the operational period,
- e. Perform other assigned task.

11. Other LGU departments/offices

- a. Assist and support the MDRRMC and BDRRMC throughout the operational period of the Lenten Season 2023.
- b. Perform other assigned task.

12. Civil Society Organizations and other volunteers

- a. Shall coordinate and report directly to the PNP for proper deployment
- b. Shall be responsible on the safety and refreshments of their respective members on duty
- c. Perform other assigned task

SECTION VII. INFORMATION, EDUCATION CAMPAIGN

All barangay officials, all national and local government agency concerned resorts owners and religious activity organizers shall conduct an information, education drive for a peaceful and safe observance of Lenten Season 2023.

SECTION VIII. SUBMISSION OF SITUATIONAL REPORTS

- A. All offices and agencies concerned during Semana Santa are hereby advised to submit situational report (daily) from April 6-10, 2023 to the office of MDRRMO.
- B. MDRRMO is hereby advised to consolidate all submitted reports to be forwarded at the PDRRMO copy furnished to OCD, MLGOO, and Office of the Municipal Mayor.

This order shall take effect immediately.
