EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35

REORGANIZING THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) ON POLLUTION CONTROL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003, an Act Providing for an Ecological Solid Waste Management Program, creating the necessary institutional mechanisms and incentives, declaring certain acts prohibited and providing penalties, appropriating funds therefor, and for other purposes or shall be known as the “Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000”;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6969, an Act to Control Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes, Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof, and for Other Purposes or shall be known as the “Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Control Act of 1990”;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8749, an Act Providing for a Comprehensive Air Pollution Control Policy and for Other Purposes or shall be known as the “Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999”;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9275, an Act Providing for a Comprehensive Water Quality Management and for Other Purposes or shall be known as the “Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004”;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 1586, Establishing an Environmental Statement System Including Other Environmental Management Related Measures and for Other Purposes;

WHEREAS, to fully operationalize this program, there is a need to reorganize a Technical Working Group on Pollution Control in the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the **Reorganizing the Technical Working Group on Pollution Control** in the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan:

SECTION 1. CREATION. The **Reorganized Technical Working Group on Pollution Control** is hereby reorganized as follows:

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The TWG shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a) To ensure compliance with the requirements of Presidential Decree 1586, Republic Act (RA) 6969, RA 8749, RA 9003, RA 9275, their respective implementing rules and regulations, and other pertinent rules and regulations where appropriate;
- b) To identify and/or cause the identification of significant environmental aspects and impacts of the establishment's operational activities and recommend possible mitigating measures in the formulation/preparation and/or review of the Environmental Management Plan and Contingency Plan;
- c) To attend to and/or cause the securing of all permitting and registration requirements of LGU Bayambang prior to the construction or installation of pollution control

- d) To ensure the proper performance, operation, and maintenance of environmental management facilities or systems of LGU Bayambang such as the following:
- Wastewater treatment facilities
 - Air pollution control devices referred to in DENR Administrative Order (DAO) 2000-03
 - Hazardous waste management storage areas (permanent or temporary)
 - Solid waste segregation/management facilities (i.e. MRFs, sanitary landfills, composting facilities, etc.)
 - Environmental monitoring devices such as the Continuous Emission Monitoring Systems, Air Monitoring Stations, effluent flow metering/measuring devices, groundwater monitoring wells, and other environmental monitoring devices;
- e) Ensure that the hazardous waste disposed offsite are covered by a Permit to Transport; each transport is covered by hazardous waste manifest duly signed by the transporter and TSD facility; and with corresponding Certificate of Treatment (COT) duly signed by the TSD Facility, Copies of the signed hazardous waste manifest and (COT) shall be submitted to the concerned EMB Regional Office in accordance with DENR Adm. Or No. 2004-36;
- f) To monitor and/or cause compliance to the requirements specified in the Environmental Compliance Certificate and the commitments stipulated in the Environmental Management and Monitoring Plans or Environmental Performance Report and Management Plans, and report the same in the Compliance Monitoring Report (CMR);
- g) To monitor and/or cause the monitoring of activities pertaining to the installation or construction of pollution source and control facilities to ensure compliance with the National Emission Standards for Source Specific Air Pollutants and National Ambient Air Quality Standards and report monitoring results to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as part of the SMR;
- h) To monitor and/or cause the monitoring of activities pertaining to the operation and maintenance of pollution control facilities to ensure compliance with the Effluent Standards and report monitoring results to DENR as part of the SMR;
- i) To promptly submit and/or cause the submission of duly accomplished, signed, and validated CMRs and SMRs;
- j) To attend and/or cause appearance of responsible personnel in technical conferences, hearings, and meetings especially on matters pertaining to pollution cases of the establishment;
- k) To keep ourselves abreast with the requirements of the DENR;
- l) To coordinate regulatory programs and activities with the provincial/municipal governments (if applicable);
- m) To initiate and intensify and/or cause initiation/intensification of environmental management activities including awareness campaign within their organization;
- n) To participate and/or cause participation in multi-partite monitoring team activities and meetings, where applicable;

- o) To determine and enumerate the LGU's Commitment to Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) from their technical inspection;
- p) To update online the requirement and checklist for environmental compliance of concern facilities;
- q) To Design and Detailed Estimate as one of the main requirements. (For submission of Engineer's Report(ER), Self-Monitoring Report (SMR), Compliance Monitoring report (CMR);
- r) To conduct joint ocular inspection of various location and facilities concerning the environmental compliance of DENR; and
- s) Initiate and Intensify environmental management activities including awareness campaign within the Municipality.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This executive order shall take effect immediately and will continue until amended or revoked.

Let copies of this Order be furnished to Offices and Departments concerned, for their information, guidance and appropriate action.
