#### **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 48**

AN ORDER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL SEPTAGE MANAGEMENT COUNCIL AND THE CREATION OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG) OF THE COUNCIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, **PANGASINAN** 

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that local government units (LGU) shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that, "The State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthy ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature";

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 9275 or the Philippine Clear Water Act of 2004, specifically Sections 7, 8, and 20 therefore, mandates the establishment of a sewerage and septage management, and sewerage collection, treatment and disposal programs for water utilities, such as the Bayambang Water District, and the Municipality of Bayambang is statutorily bounded to share that responsibility in the management and improvement of water quality within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Municipal Government to exert efforts in ensuring the efficient and effective implementation of the State's environmental laws and exact compliance to the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO. Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the Reorganization of the Municipal Septage Management Council and the Creation of Technical Working Group (TWG) for said Council in the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan:

# **SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES.** The TWG shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- a) Conduct consultations within the group, as well as with other local and national offices, agencies, organizations, or institutions, public and private, with respect to the extent, applicability, practicability, attainability, sustainability, and economy in the management and improvement of water quality within the jurisdiction;
- b) Render reports to the Office of the Mayor through the Secretariat;
- c) Attend to and/or cause the securing of all permitting and registration requirements of LGU Bayambang prior to the construction or installation of septage facility including, but not limited to, securing of necessary permits and renewal thereof;
- d) Submit proposal/s, rules and regulations, for the implementation of septage management to ensure the proper performance, operation, and maintenance of facility or systems of LGU Bayambang;

- e) To monitor and/or cause the monitoring of activities pertaining to the operation and maintenance of pollution control facilities such as for septage;
- f) To attend and/or cause appearance of responsible personnel in technical conferences, hearings, and meetings especially on matters pertaining to septage management;
- g) To coordinate regulatory programs and activities with the provincial/municipal governments (if applicable);
- h) To initiate and intensify and/or cause initiation/intensification of water management activities including awareness campaign; and
- i) To participate and/or cause participation in multi-partite monitoring team activities and meetings, where applicable.

**SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT.** Secretariat support shall be lodged with the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office, which shall be responsible for the documentation of proceedings of meetings and preparation of reports and other documents as needed by the Technical Working Group. The Secretariat shall keep all records, documents and reports of the Group even after its dissolution, and shall furnish copies thereof to any office of the Local Government of Bayambang.

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This executive order shall take effect immediately and will continue until amended or revoked.

Let copies of this Order be furnished to Offices and Departments concerned, for their information, guidance and appropriate action.
